- Blue Ridge Relay (BRR) was held September 6, 2013. Theresa & Daniel worked in the contact station. Volunteers (Rhonda, Regina, Moe & Joann) arrived at 5:00 a.m. There were about 1600 runners & the weather was wonderful.
- Have not heard back from the WCHMF regarding a raise in their donation amount to the Friends' group due to the increase of income that the Wayne C Festival brings. The letter was sent to Wayne C. Henderson.
- The Friends hosted the staff & volunteer appreciation lunch on Wednesday, August 7, 2013. BBQ, Cole slaw, buns, beans and lemonade for the drinks was served. Approximately 27 persons attended and delivery to Daniel in the contact station & Juanita in the Country Store. Rhonda assisted with serving.
- The MP3 player for the bird call program has not been ordered.
- The Albert Hash Memorial was held the Saturday of Labor Day weekend from 10 – 7. It rained in the afternoon. Attendance was down from the previous year. Admission was \$10 with 12 & under free.
- The fundraising for Tom Walls held at the Rugby Rescue Squad on Saturday, July 27<sup>th</sup> at 5:00 raised a little more than \$4,000.
